THANK YOU for your support for the Souper Bowl of Caring again this year! Sunday school children served homemade soup with crackers, fruit, and bread to a very hungry congregation. It was an enriching experience for all! \$1.00 per bowl was the suggested donation and the children collected \$187.25 that will be delivered to the Napa Food Bank, the local mission selected again this year as recipient of the funds.

Souper Bowl of Caring is youth across the nation working to fight hunger and poverty in their communities. Around the time of the Super Bowl football game, in the weeks leading up to or on Super Bowl Sunday, or during the month of February, young people take up a collection (many use a soup pot). They ask for one dollar or one item of food for people in need. They give 100% of their donation directly to the local hunger-relief charity of their choice. More than \$92 million in dollars and food for local hunger-relief charities has been collected since the movement began in 1990! CPC has participated for many years.
